ELECTRIC CLASSIFICATIONS

Discipline/Category	Description
Journeyman Lineman (JRNYLNMAN)	Skilled workers having been previously classed by the Company as First Class Linemen, who possess
	the required knowledge, skill and physical ability
	to perform any work which they may be called
	upon to do on the Company's transmission and
	distribution lines. Experience with other
	companies shall be considered in computing
	his/her time at the trade.
Hot Apprentice (Hotapprntc)	Apprentices who have reached a level of expertise
	where they can be in the primary service under
	the direct supervision of a journeyman lineman.
Cold Apprentice (CLDAPPRNTC)	Apprentices who are allowed to perform non-
	energized electrical work under the direct
	Supervision of a qualified individual.
Groundman (groundman)	Individuals who do not meet the classification of
	Apprentice or Journeyman lineman.
Equipment Operator (EQPMNTOPR)	Individuals who accompany requested equipment
	and are deemed certified to operate such
	equipment.
Mechanic (Mechanic)	The mechanic is responsible for repairing and
	maintaining equipment on a project. They will
	work on site, in a yard and with vendors to make
	sure equipment is working properly and up to
	current inspection dates.
Safety Representative (SFTYREP)	The safety representative shall be responsible for
	documentation, training and distribution of safety
	material among field personnel and management.
	They shall also work with the field personnel
	through audits and field observations to make
	sure standard safe work practices are being
	followed. In the event safe work practices are not
	being followed they will be reported through the
	appropriate supervisory structure.
