Kansas Personnel Qualifications

### COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE (CDL) CLASSES W/ENDORSEMENTS

For the CRMCS system, a responder must possess and provide proof of a valid Kansas commercial driver's license to be issued the following credentials. Kansas follows federal guidelines that provide for three classifications of commercial motor vehicles (CMV's) as described below.

<b>Expertise</b>	<b>Definition</b>
<b>CDL Class A</b> [KS_CD_L_A]	Any combination of vehicles with a gross combination weight rating (GCWR) of 26,001 or more pounds provided the GVWR of the vehicle(s) being towed is in excess of 10,000 pounds.
<b>CDL Class B</b> [KS_CD_L_B]	Any single vehicle with a gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) of 26,001 or more pounds, or any such vehicle towing a vehicle not in excess of 10,000 pounds GVWR.
<b>CDL Class C</b> [KS_CD_L_C]	Any single vehicle, or combination of vehicles, that does not meet the definition of Class A or Class B, but is either designed to transport 16 or more passengers, including the driver, or is transporting material that has been designated as hazardous.  <b>Note:</b> A bus may be either Class B or Class C depending on whether the GVWR is 26,001 pounds or more.

# Comprehensive Resource Management and Credentialing System

## ESF 1 Personnel Credentialing

Additional endorsements are necessary for certain commercial driving requirements. These endorsement qualifications should accompany a CDL Class (A, B, or C) qualification on the credentialing card and are not intended to be standalone qualifications.

<b>T - Double/Triples</b> [CDL_ENDR_T]
<b>H - Hazmat</b> [CDL_ENDR_H]
<b>N - Tank</b> [CDL_ENDR_N]
<b>P - Passenger</b> [CDL_ENDR_P]
<b>S - School Bus</b> [CDL_ENDR_S]
<b>X - Combined Hazmat and Tank</b> [CDL_ENDR_X]
