Each piece of deployable equipment inventoried into Resource Manager Web must either have a federal qualification or one of these state-level qualifications. Within RMW, these categories can be found under the Equipment tab -> Qualifications-> State-> Kansas Map Categories. These state qualifications, along with the preloaded federal qualification within RMW are identical to the categories used to search for equipment with the Kansas-MAP application (http://maps.kansastag.gov/kansas_mapv4/).

**** These are only state-level qualifications. The federal qualifications will still be listed under the ESF specific qualification drop down. If the piece of equipment meets a federal standard you would NOT select a state qualification.**

These qualification categories were created and defined by representatives from each of the state level Emergency Support Function lead agencies as well as input from the Comprehensive Resource Management and Credentialing System (CRMCS) Charter Group.

Equipment Description (Code)

Definition

911 System, Portable (SYS911PORT)

Deployable public emergency call system

Access Point (AP), Wi-Fi (2.4 GHz) (APWIFI24)

Wireless LAN access point operating on 2.4 GHz using the 802.11 standard

Acoustic Device (CRCNTAC)

Warning and directional acoustic device designed to communicate with authority and intelligibility

Agent Fogger (CRCNFOG)

Crowd control device used to distribute pepper fog and other agents

Agent Launcher (CRCNAGT)

Crowd control device which launches munitions (e.g. 40mm grenade launcher, Pepperball)

Air Bag, Lifting, High-Pressure Set (ARBGLFTHP)

Low profile 120 PSI extrication air-bags, lift heights usually measured in inches

Air Bag, Lifting, Low-Pressure Set (ARBGLFTLP)

High lift extrication air-bags, operate at 10 PSI, lift heights usually measured in feet

Air Compressor, Breathing Air (ACMPBAIR)

2216 / 4500 psi, filters, tested, certified, breathing-air compressor

Air Compressor, Pneumatic (ACMPPNMTTC)

150 psi, working air compressor

Air Conditioner/Heater (ARCNDHEAT)

A portable device used to heat or cool an area (Include CFM in notes page)

Aircart, Portable Supplied Air System (ARCARTPORT)

Multi Bottle Breathing-air cart system with valved controls for bottle exchanges without in-line air-supply interruption

Aircraft, Fixed Wing, Medical (ARCFTFWMED)

Air ambulance that conforms to requirements outlined in K.A.R. 109-2-13

Aircraft, Rotary Wing (ARCFTRTWNG)

An aircraft, especially a helicopter, that is kept partially or completely airborne by airfoils rotating around a vertical axis

Aircraft, Rotary Wing, Medical (ARCFTRWMED)

Rotorwing ambulance that conforms to the requirements of K.A.R. 109-2-12

Aircraft, Single Engine (ARCFTSE)

Single engine airplane

Aircraft, Twin Engine (ARCFTTE)

An airplane with multiple engines

Air-Pack (AIRPACK)

Self Contained Breathing Apparatus NFPA / OSHA / DOT approved

All Terrain Vehicle (ATV), Fire (ATVFIRE)

ATV w/hand equipment for grass fires

All Terrain Vehicle (ATV), General (ATVGENERAL)

A vehicle with a seat that is straddled by a single operator, with handlebars for steering control

All Terrain Vehicle (ATV), LE Patrol (LEATV)

ATV equipped for law enforcement patrol use (e.g. emergency lights)

All Terrain Vehicle (ATV), Medic (ATVMEDIC)

An all terrain vehicle designed and configured to transport to respond to medical emergencies. Differs from UTV, Medic in that the ATV, Medic is not designed to transport a patient only responder and medical supplies

Ambulance, ALS (ALSAMB)

Type I or IIA ambulance as defined by K.A.R. 109-2-6

Ambulance, BLS (BLSAMB)

Type II ambulance as defined by K.A.R. 109-2-6

Ambulance, Critical Care Transfer (CCTAMB)

Type V ambulance as defined by K.A.R. 109-2-6

Amplifier, Bi-Directional Cellular (AMPBDCELL)

Power amplifier designed to extend the range of cellular networks

Amplifier, Bi-Directional Radio (AMPBDRAD)

Power amplifier designed to extend the range of radio (non-cellular) networks

Amplifier, Wi-Fi (2.4 GHz) (AMPWIFI24)

Power amplifier designed to extend the range of 802.11 Wi-Fi networks

Asphalt Oil Distributer (DTASPH1000)

Asphalt oil distributer

Atmospheric Monitor, 4 Gas (ATMMNTR4GS)

Calibrated electronic multi gas air quality testing system

Audio Recorder, Digital (AUDRCDRDGT)

Handheld digital recording audio device, plugs into computer via USB, separates sound in tracks

Auger (Attachment) (AUGER)

Truck mounted / earth auger (digger) how big and how deep a hole should be included in notes field

Barricade, Concrete (BARCDCNCT)

A barricade made of concrete

Barricade, Direction Indicator (BARCDDI)

A direction indicator barricade as defined by NCHRP-353

Barricade, Pedestrian (CRCNPED)

Portable barricade used to control and channel crowds

Barricade, Type 1 (BARCDT1)

A type 1 barricade as defined by NCHRP-350

Barricade, Type 2 (BARCDT2)

A type 2 barricade as defined by NCHRP-351

Barricade, Type 3 (BARCDT3)

A type 3 barricade as defined by NCHRP-352

Barricade, Water Filled (BARCDH2O)

A plastic barricade that can be filled with water

Barricade, Wood (BARCDWOOD)

A barricade made of wood

Blade, Box (Attachment) (BXBLADE)

Terrain leveler, attaches to tractor

Blanket Cache - 1 to 25 (BKC1T25)

Blankets to support minimal shelter operations (1-25)

Blanket Cache - 26 to 50 (BKC26T50)

Blankets to support small-medium scale shelter operations (26-50)

Blanket Cache - 51 to 75 (BKC51T75)

Blankets to support medium scale shelter operations (51-75)

Blanket Cache - 76 to 100 (BKC76T100)

Blanket Cache - 101 to 250 (BKC101T250)

Blankets to support large-scale shelter operations (101-250)

Blanket Cache - 251 to 500 (BKC251T500)

Blankets to support large scale shelter operations (251-500)

Blower, Handheld (BLWRHDHLD)

Leaf blower

Blower, Ventilation (BLWRVENT)

Electric clean air ventilation fan

Blower, Ventilation, Heater (BLWRHEAT)

Heated electric clean air ventilation fan

Boat, Air (BOATAIR)

A small open boat having a very shallow draft and driven by a caged airplane propeller mounted above the rear transom

Boat, Jon (BOATJON)

Flat bottom vessel 14 to 20 feet in length propelled by an outboard motor less than 65 horsepower

Boat, Patrol, Inboard (LEBTIB)

Boat powered by inboards, jet drives, or inboard-outboard (I/O) drives. Engines can be gasoline or diesel systems used for law enforcement

Boat, Patrol, Outboard (LEBTOB)

Boat powered by outboards, jet drives, or inboard-outboard (I/O) drives. Engines can be gasoline or diesel systems used for law enforcement

Boat, Personal Watercraft (LEH20)

A jet drive vessel that is made to sit or stand on usually less than 15 feet in length.

Boat, Pontoon (BOATPNTN)

A flattish boat that relies on two to three cylinder pontoons to float

Body Bag, Chemical, Small (CHBDYBAGSM)

One case. Chemical-resistant body bag for human remains size small. Not associated with a mass fatality trailer

Body Bag, Chemical, Medium (CHBDYBAGMD)

One case. Chemical-resistant body bag for human remains size medium. Not associated with a mass fatality trailer

Body Bag, Chemical, Large (CHBDYBAGLG)

One case. Chemical-resistant body bag for human remains size large. Not associated with a mass fatality trailer

Body Bag, Chemical, Extra Large (CHBDYBAGXL)

One case. Chemical-resistant body bag for human remains size extra large. Not associated with a mass fatality trailer

Body Bag, Small (BODYBAGSM)

One case. A zippered bag designed for transporting human remains, size small. Not associated with a mass fatality trailer

Body Bag, Medium (BODYBAGMD)

One case. A zippered bag designed for transporting human remains, size medium. Not associated with a mass fatality trailer

Body Bag, Large (BODYBAGLG)

One case. A zippered bag designed for transporting human remains, size large. Not associated with a mass fatality trailer

Body Bag, Extra Large (BODYBAGXL)

One case. A zippered bag designed for transporting human remains, size extra large. Not associated with a mass fatality trailer

Boring Equipment, Electric (BRQUPELCTR)

Equipment to bore electrical lines in ground

Breaker, Electric (BRKRELEC)

Electric Jack Hammer, usually 40 lb breaker

Breaker, Hydraulic (BRKRHYRLC)

Hydraulically powered Jack Hammer, usually 40 lb breaker or 90 lb breaker

Breaker, Pavement (Attachment) (BRKRPVMNT)

Attachment for back hoe, impactor to break pavement

Bullhorn (BULLHORN)

Handheld device allowing users to speak loudly to groups (i.e. to gather media for news conference)

Camera, Search (CMRASRCH)

Search Camera with display screen, fixed length or extendable

Camera, Thermal Imaging, Infrared (CAMERATIR)

Hand held thermal imaging camera

Canine, Accelerant Detection (LEK9ACEL)

Canine trained to detect accelerants

Canine, Disaster (K9DIST)

Certified (Kansas Search and Rescue Standards) Live Find Search K9

Canine, Explosive Detection (LEK9EXPL)

Canine trained to detect explosives

Canine, Land Human Remains (K9LNDCDVR)

Canine trained to detect human remains on land

Canine, Narcotics Detection (LEK9NARC)

Canine trained to detect narcotics

Canine, Patrol (LEK9PAT)

Canine trained in handler protection, tracking and LE patrol use

Canine, Tracking (LEK9TRK)

Canine trained to track typically by ground disturbance

Canine, Trailing (LEK9TRL)

Canine trained to trail typically by scent discrimination

Canine, Water Human Remains (K9WTRCDVR)

Canine trained to detect human remains in the water

Canine, Wilderness (K9WILD)

Certified (Kansas Search and Rescue Standards) Wide Area Search K9

Canoe (CANOE)

A light, open, slender boat that has pointed ends and is propelled by paddles. Typically designed for one to three people

Canteen, Mobile (CNTEENMOBL)

Vehicle equipped to provide mass care feeding support on-location at disaster sites

CHEMPACK, EMS (CHEMPKE)

Federally pre-deployed organophosphate and nerve agent antidotes in FDA approved containers with mostly auto injector treatments available. One container, 454 casualty capacity

CHEMPACK, Hospital (CHEMPKH)

Federally pre-deployed organophosphate and nerve agent antidotes in FDA approved containers with mostly multi-dose vial treatments available. One container, 1,000 casualty capacity

Chipper, Electric (CHPPRELCTR)

Machine used to chip trees and branches from power lines

Chisel Kit, Pneumatic (CHISELKIT)

Air impact chisel with multiple interchangeable tips

Chute, Squeeze (CHUTESQZE)

Used to restrain large animals. Closed back, head restraint, sides can be moved inwards to restrain the animal

Command System, Accountability (CMNDACT)

On-Scene ICS structured accountability system

Communications System, Hard-Wire (COMMSYSTEM)

Confined Space communications system (Hard Wired)

Compactor, Sanitation, Garbage Truck (CMPTSANTN)

Truck in compactor used for garbage hauling

Compactor, Vibratory, Roller (RLFLATLDSP)

Roller for asphalt/terrain compaction (Include Specs such as Double Drum, Pneumatic Tire, Single Padded Drum, and Single Smooth Drum in the notes field)

Concrete Coring Tool (CNCRTCRRNG)

2 inch diameter Concrete Coring drill and bit assembly

Containment Berm (CNTMTBERM)

Container to contain contaminated runoff from vehicles

Containment Bladder (CNTMTBLDR)

Bladder to contain contaminated runoff

Containment Pool (CNTMTPOOL)

4x4 6x6 pools to contain leaking product or contaminated runoff

Copier, Portable (COPIERPRTB)

Copies documents (i.e. flyers, news releases)

Corral, Portable (CORRALPORT)

Cattle panels configured to quickly assemble into a corral

Cot Cache - 1 to 25 (CTC1T25)

Traditional cots to support small-scale shelter operations

Cot Cache - 26 to 50 (CTC26T50)

Traditional cots to support small-medium scale shelter operations

Cot Cache - 51 to 75 (CTC51T75)

Traditional cots to support medium to large scale shelter operations

Cot Cache - 76 to 100 (CTC76T100)

Traditional cots to support large scale shelter operations

Cot Cache - 101 to 250 (CTC101T250)

Traditional cots to support large scale shelter operations

Cot Cache - 251 to 500 (CTC251T500)

Traditional cots to support large scale shelter operations

Crash Attenuator (ATCRSHATNR)

A device designed to absorb energy from a motor vehicle collision, in order to reduce the damage to vehicles that are prone to being struck from behind has a flashing directional sign to draw attention

Cross Arms, Electric (XARMELCTR)

Material used on electrical poles to support lines

Cutter, Brush (Attachment) (CUTTERBRSH)

Slope mower used cut back grass or brush

Cutter, Rebar, Electric (CTTRRBR)

Hydraulic or manually operated Re-Bar cutting tool

Decontamination Structure, Mobile (DECONSTMBL)

Trailer, inflatable structures etc. to house decontamination facilities

Digger/Derrick, Electric (DGGERELCTR)

Equipment used to dig and set electrical power poles

Digital Camera/Camcorder (HDVIDCAM)

Portable digital recording device; record events, news conference, etc.
(viewed on computer/DVD)

Disposable PPE (gloves, booties, tyvek, coveralls) (DISPPPE)

Disposable personal protective equipment

Dosimeter (DOSIMETER)

Instrument to measure absorbed dose of radiation

Drill Rig (DRILLRIG)

Mechanical equipment to dig monitoring wells

Drill/Hammer, Electric (DRILLHAMMR)

Hammer Drill 1/2 inch or larger diameter drive

Dust/Particulate Respirators, Disposable (DSTRSPRDSP)

Disposable respirators, paper mask, i.e. N-95

DVD Player (DVDPLYR)

Portable device that plays DVDs for viewing news or television shows

DVD Recorder (DVDRCRDR)

Portable device that records news or television shows on DVDs for playback

Easel (EASEL)

Portable stand for holding large paper on which to write information for training or general public

Fault Detection Equipment, Electric (FTDETCTEQP)

Equipment to detect electrical faults

Fiberscope (FBRSCOPE)

Fiber Optic Search Camera with Eye piece or display screen

Floodlight, Portable (FLDLGTSPRT)

A portable lighting system without a generator requires power source

Forklift (FORKLIFT)

Will be listed as a vehicle and attachment

Fuel Tank, Diesel, Portable (FLTKDSLPRRT)

Transportable container for diesel fuel

Fuel Tank, Gasoline, Portable (FLTKGASPRT)

Transportable container for gasoline fuel

Fuel Tank, Other, Portable (FLTKOTRPRT)

Transportable container for other fuel types

Fuel Tank, Propane, Portable (FUELLPPORT)

Transportable container for propane fuel

Gas and Radiation Detector, Wireless (GSRADDCTWL)

4 gas monitor with radiation monitoring sensor and radio transmitter
measures LEL, O2, H2s, CO

Gas Detector, Wireless (GASDTCTRWL)

4 gas monitor with PID and radio transmission

Gas Monitor, PID ppb range (GASMNTRPID)

Photo ionization detector with 10.6 lamp measuring VOC's in Parts per billion range

Generator, up to 5 KW (GNTRUPTO5)

A generator with an output of up to 5 KW (Include Portable, Skid mounted, or trailer mounted in notes field)

Generator, 6 to 12 KW (GNTR6TO12)

A generator with an output of 6 to 12 KW (Include Portable, Skid mounted, or trailer mounted in notes field)

Generator, 13 to 25 KW (GNTR13TO25)

A generator with an output of 13 to 25 KW (Include Portable, Skid mounted, or trailer mounted in notes field)

Generator, 26 to 124 KW (GNTR26T124)

A generator with an output of 26 to 124KW (Include Portable, Skid mounted, or trailer mounted in notes field)

Geoprobe, Direct push for subsurface sampling (GEOPROBE)

Metal rod or pipe to obtain subsoil samples

GPS Camera (GPSCAMERA)

A camera with a built in GPS receiver; when inventories list accuracy of GPS in the notes field

GPS Camera, Compass (GPSCAMCMPS)

A camera with a built in GPS receiver and compass; when inventories list accuracy of GPS in the notes field

GPS Camera, Range Finder (GPSCAMRFND)

A camera with a built in GPS receiver and range finder; when inventories list accuracy of GPS in the notes field

GPS Units, Mapping Grade (GPSCANMPGD)

A mapping grade GPS unit used to collect GPS and GIS data in the field; when inventories list accuracy of GPS in the notes field

GPS Units, Navigational (GPSNAVGTNL)

A navigational GPS unit used to navigate from location to location, GPS collection limited to way points only

GPS Units, Recreational Grade (GPSRECRGRD)

A recreational grade GPS unit used to collect GPS and limited GIS data as way points in the field

GPS Units, Survey Grade (GPSSRVYGRD)

A survey grade GPS unit used to collect GPS and GIS data in the field; when inventories list accuracy of GPS in the notes field

Gun, Captive Bolt (GUNCAPBOLT)

Stuns and kills cattle instantly and painlessly using a steel bolt that retracts and is reset for next animal

Hammer, Demolition, Electric (HAMMERDEMO)

Electric Hammer, usually 10 - 15 lb handheld tool

Hand Tools, Electric (HNDTOOLELT)

Tools used for electrical work

Hand Tools, Gas (HNDTOOLGAS)

Tools used for gas work

Hazmat Suit, Type A (HZMATSUITA)

Totally encapsulating chemical protective suit use with SCBA

Hazmat Suit, Type B (HZMATSUITB)

Splash protective chemical suit use with SCBA

Heater, Electric (HEATERELCT)

A electric powered portable heater

Heater, Propane (HEATERPROP)

A propane powered portable heater

Horse, LE Patrol / Crowd Control (LEHORSE)

Horse trained and equipped for LE crowd control use

Horse, LE Search / Auxiliary (LEHORAUX)

Horse trained and equipped for search and rescue use

Hydraulic Vehicle Rescue System (HYDVRSCSYS)

Vehicle Extrication tools, minimum of a Power Unit, a Spreader, a Cutter, and a Ram

Internet Provider, Satellite Feed (IPSATFEED)

Hardware (usually a dish) that provides internet access via satellite

Kayak (KAYAK)

Recreational boat that typically hold one person and glide easily through the water. Unlike the canoe, which is broader and open, the kayak typically has a more slender profile and is covered on top

Kennel, Pet, Small (KNLPETSM)

Approximately 30"x19"x22" and smaller crates/cages for animal disaster response/sheltering operations

Kennel, Pet, Medium (KNLPETMED)

Approximately 30"x19"x22" crates/cages for animal disaster response/sheltering operations

Kennel, Pet, Large (KNLPETLRG)

Approximately 48"x30"x36" crates/cages for animal disaster response/sheltering operations

Kennel, Pet, Extra Large (KNLPETELRG)

Approximately 48"x30"x36" and larger crates/cages for animal disaster response/sheltering operations

Kennel, Pet, Run (KNLPETRUN)

An outdoor enclosure for domestic animals or poultry

Kitchen, Mobile (KITCHMOBL)

Self-contained vehicle equipped to operate for mass care feeding operations in the field

Leak Detector, Gas (LKDTCTRGAS)

Device used to locate underground gas leaks

Light Set, Generator (GENLGTST)

A portable lighting system with generator

Line Locator, Electric (LNLOCELCTR)

Locating device used to locate underground electrical lines

Line Locator, Gas (LNLOGGAS)

Locating device used to locate underground gas lines

Listening Device, Acoustic (LSTNGDVCEA)

Delsar life detector system or equivalent Acoustic listening system

Listening Device, Seismic (LSTNGDVCS)

Delsar life detector system or equivalent Seismic listening system

Listening Device, Seismic and Acoustic (LSTNGDVCSA)

Delsar life detector system or equivalent combination Seismic / Acoustic listening system

Mass Arrest Kit (MAARST)

Contains forms and equipment to arrest and process large numbers of persons at one time

Mercury Vacuum (HgVAC)

Vacuum with special carbon filter for use with Mercury

Mercury Vapor Analyzer (HgVAPANLZR)

Vapor analyzer to detect and measure Mercury vapor concentration

Mesh Surveillance System (MESHSURV)

A portable system using WI-FI to permit realtime video and audio surveillance of an area

Microphone, Handheld (MCRPHNHAND)

Portable device to plug into equipment (i.e. video camera/ podium) to amplify sound

Microphone, Lavalier (MCRPHNLVLR)

Portable device to wear on lapel or plug into equipment (i.e. video camera/podium) to amplify sound

Mobile Breathing Air Cascade Unit (4500 psi) (MLBRTCSCD)

Truck with minimum of 3 360 cubic feet cylinders

Mobile Breathing Air Compressor Unit (2261 psi) (MLBRTCMR)

Truck/trailer with breathing air compressor

Mobile Communications Center (MOBLEECC)

Only for units that do not meet the federal standards. Please list specs for the vehicle in the notes field

Mobile Crime Scene Laboratory (CSILAB)

Self contained unit that permits onsite collection and processing of criminal evidence

Mobile Gas Chromatograph, Shimadzu (MBLGSCRM)

Machine to measure headspace of various materials to determine contents

Mobile JIC (with GIS) (MOBLEJIC)

Mobile workstation for public information officers (computers, copiers, internet)

Monitor (MONITOR)

Flat screen monitor for computer work station which can show computer contents or works as television

Mower, Boom (Attachment) (MOBOOMTCMT)

A mower attachment at the end of boom arm

Mower, PTO (Attachment) (MOWERPTO)

Tractor with a mower deck attachment (SLOPE MOWER)

Multi-Gas Monitor (Low Oxygen Environment), Wireless (MTGASMNTWL)

See gas monitor

Overhead Conductor, Electric (OVERCONDTR)

Devices used on cross arms to conduct electricity

PA System, Portable (PASYSTMPRT)

Portable system for public speaking; plugs in to amplify sound or can use battery

Panel, Fencing (PANELFENCE)

64" to 70" Steel rail panels used to create portable corrals for livestock

Pipe, Plastic, Gas (PIPPLSTCGS)

Gas rated plastic pipe for gas distribution

Pipe, Wastewater (PPEWSTEWTR)

Pipe rated for wastewater collection

Pipe, Water, Potable, Food Grade (PIPEWTR)

Pipe rated for drinking water

Pipe, Wrapped Steel, Gas (PPEWSTELGS)

Coated steel pipe rated for gas distribution

Podium, Portable (PODIUMPORT)

Portable podium for public speaking; plugs in to amplify sound or can use battery

Pole Camera (POLECAM)

Portable camera system designed to be mounted on a pole for surveillance

Pole, Electric (POLEELCTR)

Electrical power pole

Portable Medical Facility, Tent or Inflatable (ACSTENT)

A single or series of tents or inflatable facilities designed to be utilized as a temporary medical facility at some level of care

Portable Medical Facility, Trailer (ACSTRRL)

A trailer that is designed to be utilized as a temporary medical facility to provide some level of care

Portable Traffic Signal Set (LTTRAFPORT)

Portable traffic light

Power Unit, Hydraulic (PWRUNTHYR)

Self contained hydraulic power unit for hydraulic breakers, drills, and other hydraulic tools

Projector (PRJECTR)

Portable device used to project PowerPoint presentations or photos onto large screen

Equipment and supplies to set up a community reception center within an existing structure to perform population monitoring, decontamination, and registration

Radiation Emergency Treatment Medication (RADPACK)

Federally pre-deployed (state owned) DTPA stockpiles for use after suspected internal contamination of plutonium, americium or curium. DTPA comes in 5 ml (200mg/ml) single-use, clear glass ampoules and is supplied as a colorless solution. 1,000 doses per package

Radiation Portal Monitor (RADPRTLMTMTR)

Radiation monitor for personnel to walk through, some monitors vehicles can drive through

Radiation Survey Meters (RADSrvYMTR)

Radiation meters, low range and high range to detect and measure radiation

Radio Cache, 700/800 MHz P-25 (RAD78DIG)

Pre-assembled group of handheld radios, 700/800Mhz, P25 compliant

Radio Cache, 800 MHz Analog Only (RADEIGAN)

Pre-assembled group of handheld radios, 800Mhz analog

Radio Cache, Multi-Band (RADMLTBND)

Pre-assembled group of handheld radios, Multiband

Radio Cache, UHF (RADUHF)

Pre-assembled group of handheld radios, UHF band

System for printing incident specific accountability identification cards

Repeater, Wi-Fi (2.4 GHz) (RPTRWIFI24)

Wireless LAN repeater operating on 2.4 GHz using the 802.11 standard

Respirator, Air Purifying Full Facepiece (RSPRTRAPFL)

Respirator that cover entire face and has filter cartridges

Respirator, Air Purifying Half Mask (RSPRTRAPHF)

Respirator that covers mouth and nose only and has filter cartridges

RFID Reader (RFIDRDR)

A device used to communicate with RFID tags. The reader has one or more antennas, which emit radio waves and receive signals

Robot, EOD / Tactical (LEROBOT)

A machine that performs various complex acts in the performance of explosive ordinance disposal

Robot, LE Surveillance (SURVRBT)

Concrete cutting Chainsaw, gasoline powered

Saw, Chain, Concrete, Hydraulic (SAWCHNCHYD)

Concrete cutting Chainsaw, hydraulic powered

Saw, Chain, Hydraulic (SAWCHNHYDR)

Chainsaw hooked up to hydraulic system on vehicle or pump to cut trees

Saw, Chain, Pole (SAWCHNPOLE)

Saw, Chain, Ventilation (SAWCHNVENT)

Wood Chainsaw, Gasoline Powered

Chainsaw leg protecting safety equipment

Saw, Circular 10" (SAWCIRC10)

Electric circular saw 10 inch diameter blade

Saw, Circular 7 1/4" (SAWCIRC7)

Electric circular saw 7 1/4 inch diameter blade

Saw, Concrete (SAWCNCRTE)

Handheld or walkbehind used for cutting concrete or asphalt

Saw, Cut Off (SAWCUTOFF)

Electric metal cutting bench top circular saw 12 inch -14 inch

Saw, Reciprocating (SAWRECIP)

Reciprocating saws-all type saw, with blades (wood, and metal, cutting)

Saw, Rotary, Gasoline (SAWROTGAS)

Gasoline powered metal cutting handheld Rotary saw 12 inch -14 inch

Scanner, Accountability (SCANNERACT)

Handheld PDA or Mobile Express system that scans credentials for personnel and equipment accountability

Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) (SCBA)

A unit with a compressed breathing air tank, regulator, full face mask and back pack frame

Machine used to make connections in gas distribution pipe

Telephone Cache, Commercial Cellular (TPHNCMCELL)

Pre-assembled group of mobile commercial phones

Telephone Network/Sets, IP, Deployable (TPHNNWKSTS)

Pre-assembled group of voice-over-IP telephone sets

Telephone, Satellite (TPHNSAT)

Handheld satellite network telephone set

Tender, Water, Gray (TNRWTGRY)

A large tank truck used to carry wastewater

Tender, Water, Potable (TNRWTPOT)

A large tank truck used to carry water for human consumption

Tent, Decontamination (TENTDECON)

Tent to house decontamination supplies & operations

Tent, Portable Facility (TENTPORTFC)

A multi-use tent structure

Theodolite, with Tripod (THEODOLITE)

Complete surveyors transit / theodolite with tri-pod

Toilet, Portable (TOILETPORT)

A portable toilet facility

Torch, Exothermic (TORCHEXOTH)

Oxygen enhanced arc / rod complete metal cutting torch

Torch, Oxygen/Acetylene Kits (TORCHOXKIT)

Petrogen or other Oxygen / Acetylene complete metal cutting torch kit

Torch, Oxygen/Fuel Gas (TORCHFUEL)

Petrogen or other Oxygen / Fuel complete metal cutting torch kit

Tower, Self Contained Portable (TOWERSCPRT)

A trailer that includes toilet and shower facilities

Trailer, Containment Boom, Disposable Oil Absorbent (TRLRCONTBM)

Trailer with absorbent supplies for various types of spills

Trailer, Exercise (TRLEREXRCS)

A trailer that holds Exercise specific equipment

Trailer, Fire, Foam Tender (TRLRFMTNDR)

Trailer with at least 500 gallons of foam concentrate

Trailer, Flat Bed (TRLRBHFB)

Include required hitch type in the notes field

Trailer, HAZMAT (TRLRHZMT)

Trailer containing various specialty items for Haz-Mat response

Trailer, Hose (TRLRHOSE)

Trailer with a minimum of 2000 ft of hose

Trailer, Hospital Surge Support (HSURGTR)

Trailer designed and equipped to provide support to a hospital surge incident or operation of an alternate care site

Trailer, Hot Line Electric (TRLRHTLECT)

Trailer for electrical hot line work

Trailer, LE Radar Speed (RADTRL)

Portable radar unit with display used to show speed of vehicles

Trailer, Line Reel Electric (TRLRLRLECT)

Trailer for carrying electrical line reels

Trailer, Livestock (TRLRLVSTCK)

Trailer used to haul livestock

Trailer, Mass Casualty Incident (MCITRL)

Trailer designed and equipped to provide additional supplies to either field or hospital operations in response to a mass casualty incident

Trailer, Mass Decontamination (TRLRMSDCON)

Trailer to provide storage and facilities for decontamination of large numbers of persons

Trailer, Mass Fatality (FATTRL)

Trailer designed and equipped to provide additional supplies to either field or hospital operations in response to a mass fatality incident

Trailer, Mobile EOC (TRLRMOBEOC)

Self-contained mobile trailer with bumper or gooseneck connectivity for towing that provides the capacity for emergency operations center operations in the field

Trailer, Mobile Police Station (MOBPD)

A self-contained trailer equipped to operate a temporary police station

Trailer, Observation Platform (OBSTRL)

A self-contained, trailer mounted system supporting a raised observation platform

Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (SURVUAV)

A powered, aerial vehicle that does not carry a human operator, mainly used for reconnaissance and intelligence-gathering

Utility Terrain Vehicles (UTV), General (UTVGENERAL)

A low speed vehicle that has a steering wheel and can accommodate at least two people. It has a cargo box and rollover cage

Utility Terrain Vehicles (UTV), Medic (UTVMEDIC)

Utility terrain vehicle designed and configured to respond to medical emergencies and transport patients away from a scene. Differs from the ATV, Medic in that the UTV, Medic is designed to transport patients and the ATV, Medic is designed to transport responder and medical supplies only

Self-contained mobile unit with the capacity for GIS/PAO support and operations in the field

Vehicle, LE CBRNE Response (LECBRNE)

A vehicle containing equipment used to support a CBRNE Team at an emergency scene

Vehicle, LE Surveillance (SURVVEH)

A self-contained unit equipped with audio and video surveillance equipment

Vehicle, Mobile EOC (VHCLMOBEOC)

Self-contained vehicle that provides the capacity for emergency operations center operations in the field.

Vehicle, Motorcycle, LE Patrol (LEMOTOR)

A motorcycle equipped for law enforcement patrol (radio, emergency lights, siren)

Vehicle, Pickup Truck (VHCLTRCK)

A light truck with an open body and low sides and a tailboard

Vehicle, Pickup Truck, 4x4 (VHCLTRK4X4)

A light truck with an open body and low sides and a tailboard with four wheel drive

Vehicle, Pickup Truck, 4x4, LE Patrol (LEPKUP4)

A 4 wheel drive pickup truck equipped for law enforcement patrol (radio, emergency lights, siren)

Vehicle, Pickup, LE Patrol (LEPKUP)

A 2 wheel drive pickup truck equipped for law enforcement patrol (radio, emergency lights, siren)

Vehicle, Post Blast Investigation (PSTBLST)

A self contained unit equipped to support the on-scene post-blast investigation

Vehicle, Prisoner Transport (LEPRIS)

A vehicle equipped to securely transport prisoners

Vehicle, Public Health Response (PHVAN)

Vehicle configured and supplied to support public health incident response operations such as mass dispensing, disease investigation or other activities

Vehicle, Sedan, LE Patrol (LEAUTO)

A sedan equipped for law enforcement patrol (radio, emergency lights, siren)

Vehicle, SUV (VHCLSUV)

A vehicle similar to a station wagon, but built on a light-truck chassis

Vehicle, SUV, 4x4 (VHCLSUV4X4)

A vehicle similar to a station wagon, but built on a light-truck chassis with four wheel drive

Vehicle, SUV, 4x4, LE Patrol (LESUV4)

A 4 wheel drive sport utility vehicle equipped for law enforcement patrol (radio, emer lights, siren)

Vehicle, SUV, LE Patrol (LESUV)

A 2 wheel drive sport utility vehicle equipped for law enforcement patrol (radio emer lights, siren)

Vehicle, Tactical Armored (TACARM)

A 2 wheel drive vehicle that is armored against penetration by small arms and rifle rounds

Vehicle, Tactical Armored, 4x4 (TACARM4)

A 4 wheel drive vehicle that is armored against penetration by small arms and rifle rounds

Vehicle, Tactical Deployment (TACDPL)

A 2 wheel drive vehicle that is equipped to transport and rapidly deploy a tactical team

Vehicle, Tactical Deployment, 4x4 (TACDPL4)

A 4 wheel drive vehicle that is equipped to transport and rapidly deploy a tactical team

Vehicle, Van (VHCLVAN)

A covered boxlike motor vehicle, typically having a rear door and sliding doors on the side panels, used for transporting goods or people

Vehicle, Van, 4x4 (VHCLVAN4X4)

A covered boxlike motor vehicle, typically having a rear door and sliding doors on the side panels, used for transporting goods or people with four wheel drive

Portable device to record onto VHS tapes - not used as much as handheld digital video camera

Video Camera (VIDCAMERA)

Portable device to record events, news conference, etc. for viewing on VHS player

Visual Inspection Device (VISINSPDEV)

Construction grade camera with extended reach boom, usually 3ft or 6ft

Voice Recorder, Deployable (VOICERECRD)

Deployable voice recorder designed to support dispatch operations

Washer, Pressure, commercial (PRSWSHCOM)

Commercial grade pressure washer ADD type of fuel (gas or diesel), PSI, and GPM in the notes field

Washer, Pressure, electric (PRWSHELEC)

Electric powered pressure washer ADD type of fuel (gas or diesel), PSI, and GPM in the notes field

Washer, Pressure, gas (PRSWSHGAS)

Gas powered pressure washer ADD type of fuel (gas or diesel), PSI, and GPM in the notes field
